



Plan A

ALL SEMESTERS

- Enroll in MSE graduate courses and/or research (research recommended but not mandatory)
- Full-time students register for MSE 6401 (1 credit)
- Students typically take 7-13 credits per term (depending on other responsibilities)

SEMESTER 1

Advisor & Research

- Discuss research interests with faculty
- Begin work in research group
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0

SEMESTER 2

Form an advisory committee

- Choose 1 major advisor and 2 associate advisors

SEMESTER 3 AND BEYOND

Continue to take graded courses toward your degree

Upon *Plan of Study* approval by Graduate School, prepare thesis

Submit *Plan of Study* to the Graduate School (after 18 credits completed)

Complete 15 graded course credits (12 must be in MSE) and 9 graded research credits (MSE 5950)

FINAL DEFENSE

Apply for graduation in Peoplesoft during last semester

Provide thesis to advisory committee 2 weeks in advance of defense

Defend thesis and obtain signatures of advisory committee

Complete IMS clearance form includes: submitting pdf of thesis, returning keys.

Announce final defense 2 weeks in advance on UConn and MSE event calendars

Review thesis submission checklist in link above

Submissions

- Submit 1 electronic copy of thesis to Digital Commons
- Submit completed thesis submission checklist, 1 signed approval page, and final exam form
